

Coyote Creek 2024-2025 Technology Policy

Coyote Creek Elementary School has made a commitment to fostering technology skills for our students and provide a device for every student to use as a learning tool in school.

- Students in kindergarten are provided iPads.
- Students in first grade through sixth grade are provided Chromebooks.
 - As of 2021, third grade students are provided a new Chromebook that is assigned to them until they leave Coyote Creek Elementary School.

Safeguards and Responsibilities of Students

- The safety and privacy of students is a priority of Coyote Creek and all Douglas County School District.
 - A content filter for all devices managed by DCSD is used to safeguard students to block inappropriate material from being viewed/accessed.
 - Only apps that have been district-approved are allowed on the devices to help ensure the safety of your student.

- Students using devices/technology are held to the same standards used for any other tool as set in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook, which they sign annually during Express Check-In.

Financial Responsibilities

- Your student is required to maintain their device in good condition and it is the student's responsibility to avoid damage to their Chromebook/iPad.
- Parents/Guardians will take full responsibility for any damage to your student's device or damage caused to another student's device by your child. Parents/Guardians will be required to reimburse DCSD in full for the cost to repair or complete replacement of said equipment if it is damaged, lost, or destroyed. Whether the device should be repaired or replaced, and the cost of such repair or replacement, will be at the sole discretion of DCSD.
 - You will be sent an email regarding any damage that happens to the device with a follow-up invoice from MySchoolBucks with the repair/replacement cost.
